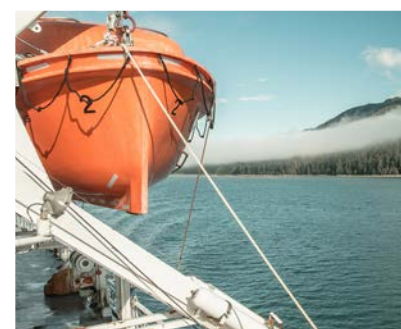
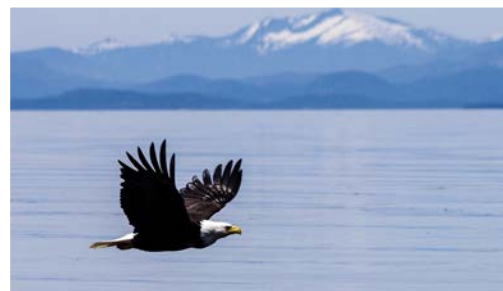


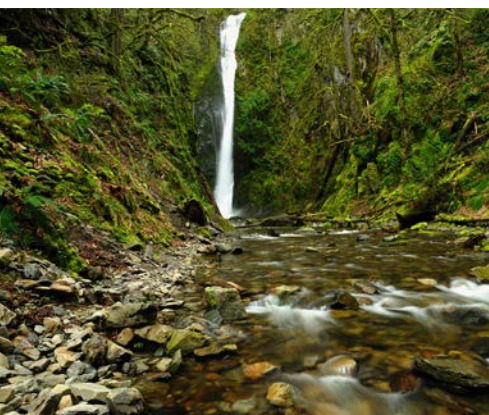
Totem Circle
